What is a *cookie*?

A *cookie* is a small file capable of storing information that is downloaded to a user's computer, Mobile or other device for the purpose of being used to provide a more personalised and improved service.

Types of cookies used by the Museum

The Museum uses only third-party cookies, which are those that are sent to the user's terminal from a server or domain that is not managed by the Museum but by other organisations that process the data obtained through such *cookies*.

The Museum may use the following cookies from the following third parties:

- Google Analytics [web analytics]
- Wordpress [To optimize Wordpress and the surrounding multi-language]
- Vimeo [Which adds the video player]
- Flickr [Which adds the image viewer]
- Twitter [See tweets and share some pages]

Can I disable or eliminate cookies?

In line with the legislation in force, users may change their settings for the use of cookies at any time, and may allow, enable, disable, block or eliminate the cookies stored on their computer. To do so, it is necessary to modify the settings for the options of the browser installed on your computer.
